Emery James Staines, born in Victoria, Australia, went to South Africa to fight in the Second Anglo-Boer War and met Maria there. They had five children in S Africa, left thereafter arriving in Western Australia in May 1920 on the *HMT Zealandic*. One, Albert Edward Staines (correspondent, Joy Staines' father-in-law) died in 1981. Their youngest, Dorothy, born 1915 Wynburg Cape Town, is still alive (2008) living in Sydney, New South Wales.

At the time of his death, Henry Rudolph Carter was a clerk in the Post Office, living at 20 Arnold Street, Observatory. His estate was valued at £1999/1/6. He was buried in the Mowbray Cemetery. Patricia Mayers a granddaughter.  
Comment: the discrepancy in ages between the partners is noted. This individual did exist, but it seems likely that there was another born later, of same name and origin.
