The letter below led to the research notes which follow. I have made no attempt at interpreting the information though I believe that it speaks for itself.

Good morning Robin

I wonder if you could help a complete stranger?

I found your name on a South Africa Genealogy website, linked to the surname ERASMUS. My research has hit a wall on my paternal grandmother. Details I have of her are: Born: Judith Cornelia Etrisia ERASMUS, sometime in the late eighteen hundreds. She married my grandfather Bernadus Ignatius Heroden DISSEL probably after the Boer War, estimate between 1902 - 1905. In 1905, she had her first child Johannes Christoffel DISSELL in Germiston. She went on to have 8 children, the first few born in Germiston, and the rest in Johannesburg. I have documentation indicating her address as Kensington Johannesburg in 1945. She must have died between then and 1951 when I was born.

# DISSEL i

A (partial) transcript of a letter to Jno Dissell of Johannesburg from The Chief Archivist for the Union of South Africa at the Houses of Parliament, (Lieut.-Col.) Dr. C Graham Botha <sup>ii</sup>.

What may be of interest is the following which he recounts: A Will [was] registered in the Orphan Chamber 27 March 1830, the then earliest such attached to a "Dessel" known, where he is called Dessell of Zwartzenburg. The spelling is contested by Jno, he's always known it as Dessel of Zchwartzenbergh!

C Graham Botha goes on to share that a Johan Frederick Deijsel van Paterborn gehuwd (married) 2de Januari 1752 met (with) Cornelia van Saxen. JFD died 31 October 1823.

Further, there is a Joint Will of Johan Christoffel Dessel van Zwartzenburg end (and) Evertina Christina born in Colony (this suggested an emancipated slave)

Family name spellings he has determined from Wills etc. are 1726-35 Dissel; 1830 Dessel; 1833 Deyssel; 1836 Dyssel; 1851 Dissel; 1853 Diesel; 1861 Deysel; 1866 Deyzel; 1870 Dysel.

Last fact he shares: Jan Maries Dissel of Oost Vriesland a soldies arrived in the colony in 1720 aboard the Barneveld and was directed to be an agriculturalist. Later, with permission of the governor, he left. Jan Philip Dissel of Bikkenbag arrived aboard the West Vriesland and went on to become a wagon maker.

A certain Nicolaas VAN DER WALT and his wife Maria Magdalena Elizabeth née VORSTER make a joint will in 1860. This is filed  $30^{\rm th}$  August 1860 following the death of NvdW.

Nicolaas van der Walt of the dist. Middelburg (so. Andries Stephanus Jacobus van der Walt and Annie Kruger) died aged 19 years on 2 August 1860 at Elandskloof dist. Middelburg. He was a sheep farmer. His wife was Maria Magdalena Elizabeth VORSTER. There were no offspring.

V To set the picture straight: I am assured by the archivist that problems relating to lineage where multiple marriages were involved, the spelling of names and identifying places accurately were not uncommon. It was often related to the uneducated nature of the people involved (citizenry and law officers); the use of English, High Dutch and the pidgin / patuá that later was to become formalised as Afrikaans; and the frequent lack of familiarity by those completing the records with rural geography, official and informal place names.

SUMMARY (edited): Colin Graham Botha (1883-1973), Chief Archivist of the Union of South Africa. Joined Cape Civil Service in 1901. In 1912 CGB became Keeper of the Archives and in 1919 the first Chief Archivist for the Union of S.A. He initiated the publication of several series of archival documents as well as the series Archives Year Books of S.A. Wrote, lectured and broadcast on history of S.A. Was member of various societies inter alia the Mountain Club of South Africa, St. John's Ambulance and the Duke of Edinburgh's Own Rifles.
