<sup>2</sup> The only William Duffus whose records I have been able to find to-date, and approximating this age, is William Duffus ~ 25 March 1790 Forgue, Aberdeen, son of William Duffus. Mother unnamed. Dates match well with the later marriage of December 1790

<sup>3</sup> Unfortunately, the mother is not recorded.

According to family history, this should be John Duffus, shipbuilder and mechanical engineer. The Duffus shipyard was officially known as **John Duffus & Company**. In addition to shipbuilding, Duffus manufactured engines for steam vessels; and, trading as the **Aberdeen and London Steam Navigation Company**, had his own ships plying their trade between Aberdeen and London. Inter alia the "Royal Tar" (the nickname of King William IV) was built by John Duffus, Aberdeen in 1832.

His age was recorded as 78 years and Mary Slessor 41 years (sic. 44 years)".
