Nurse Edgell: I possess original Visiting / Presentation card engraved "Nurse Edgell" and a couple of photographs with her in uniform. She was totally unschooled and when a hymn was unknown to her, had my grandmother sing a little ahead of the congregation so that she could hear and echo the words. She once found the local butcher, in state of depression, in the process of hanging himself. Having lifted him down "off the hook" she gave him a tongue lashing for being so selfish for he would only precipitated his family into even greater despair. Acknowledging the part she played in his life to the end of his, he never failed to tell all and sundry of her role in saving his life and she never again had to buy "a Sunday roast". On 18 May 1929, Nurse Edgell was presented with a purse containing £14 10s 3d "as a small sign of our regard..." by parishioners of St.Paul's, Bedminster. Her 3 children went to St. Pauls Parish Church School, Bristol (I have a school photograph). I have several wonderful photographs of Cannon Griffiths and his wife, of St. Paul's and St. Phillips. The cannon was never allowed out of the house with more than an ½ crown in his pocket for he just gave all his money away and impoverished his family.
