Elder, William Alexander (b. unknown [estimate 1880] - 16/4/1946)

The only record of this man is that he qualified MRCVS on 21 May 1902 and FRCVS in 1914, his thesis being "East African Coast Fever". He was a member of the Transvaal Veterinary Medical Association founded on 16 February 1903. He attended the Pan African Veterinary Congress held in Pretoria to coincide with the official opening of Onderstepoort on 12 January 1909 as the official representative of the Swaziland Protectorate. He also attended the 1929 Pan African Veterinary Congress held in Pretoria in this capacity (This Congress was held from 1 to 17 August 1929). He died in Swaziland on 16 April 1946.
