#### INTRODUCTORY COMMENTS

DANIEL WILHELM VOLKWYN of Hessen and Alie Bruynsward are recorded as arriving in the Cape Colony in December 1802 on the Dutch ship "Vroun Johanna", a soldier-servant to Batt van Waldeck. He was born 28<sup>th</sup> October 1779. I have seen his baptismal certificate; I have seen his wife's death notice and confirm her name.

In February 1806, J(AN) VOLKWŸN, a shoemaker and soldier to A Battery Waldeck applied to Major General Sir David Baird for permission to remain in the colony. He had a lame leg and was unable to soldier any longer. Colonel Muller certified to his character and on 13 February 1806, sponsors C F Wilhelms and T G Lankhoff, being "respectable inhabitants" stood security to this application. KAB CO 3857.137

The Dutch Reformed Church Marriage Register 1804-1872 reports a LODEWŸK VOLKWŸN of Hessen being married on 20 May 1807 to Alida VAN BRUYNSWAARD van Cabo (of the Cape). Further, a L Volkwyn arrived here on  $7^{\text{th}}$  March 1806, and received permission to remain on 17 March 1806, sponsors C F Wilhelms and T G Lankhoff  $\boxed{\text{co } 6054 \text{ Vol. } 1\text{-4; } 6055 \text{ Vol.1 No.68}}$ .

Evidence suggests that at least three VOLKWYNS came to the Cape of Good Hope: WILLEM (DANIEL WILHELM) VOLKWŸN in 1802 and J(AN) and LODEWŸK VOLKWŸN in 1806. The first one is associated with much of the Cape family. Another, through death notices dated 1806 which refer to "Jan" and his wife "Clara" is the likely origin of the Knysna family.

D W Volkwyn went on to produce a huge family line, the present descendants of whom are of "white" and "mixed" race, living largely in Cape Town, and on the Witwatersrand. In his 71 years, he had 3 wives, 11 legitimate children, a consort of colour and (at least) one offspring from that relationship.

Meanwhile, in the George/Knysna/Mosselbaai/Port Elizabeth districts of the Eastern Cape, there are Volkwyns in relative abundance. They are largely "mixed", many talented artisans (in particular carpenters, the creators of the famous Volkwyn or Grahamstown chair) and literate, and who can trace their lineage as far back as Pieter (Johannes) Volkwyn born 1806 Moordkuil, Georgetown (of Jan and Clara) died 8 April 1863. Over the years, members of this group have moved to the Western Cape, the Witwatersrand, Botswana (then the British Bechuanaland Protectorate) and Zimbabwe (then the Southern Rhodesia).

Recently discovered (2002) in Botswana, at Notwane railway siding to the south of Gaborone, is a graveyard with 5 graves, only one of which has a tombstone, white marble "open book" laid down. Inscribed thereon is H J Volkwyn (born 11.11.1853 in Georgetown,

Cape Province died 12.12.1918). The site is located approximately 500m from the railway line and approximately 500m from a river.

Thus, in the 17<sup>th</sup> century, "mixed" Volkwyns originated from both the Western Cape and the Eastern Cape geographical regions. Certain offspring of the original **DANIEL WILHELM VOLKWŸN** in the Cape were dusky and moved in a different stratum of society to the other lighter family members, becoming artisans rather than pursuing professions. This class differentiation, of course, would have become more pronounced as racial segregation became institutionalised by the British and enshrined in official government policy as "apartheid".

DISCLAIMER: This is a working paper published in the hope that it will assist others in finalising a document.

Our use of racial epithets, though unfortunate and certainly not our preference; we have considered it a necessity whilst the process of defining a hugely confusing genealogy continues. Hopefully, these will fall away with time.

# A VOLKWEIN / VOLKWŸN FAMILY LINE originating in the Cape of Good Hope

#### THE VOLKWEIN FAMILY IN EUROPE

Extract: from the Church Register of the Congregation Ehlen, District Wilhelmshöhe in Kur-Hessen under the heading "Baptised in the year One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy-nine (1779) November 5."

"Daniel Wilhelm, son of the citizen and shoemaker George Volkwein and his spouse Eleanore (born Schalägermacker) born on the twenty eight October at four o'clock in the afternoon of the above named year 1779.

Godfather. Military Surgeon Schalägermacker of Aralsen"

"The aforegoing extract is one and the same as compared with the original. Declared by Siebert, Minister for the time being, Parish Ehlen. 26 November 1818."

William Volkwyn of Hessen and Alie Bruynsward are reported to have arrived in colony in December 1802 on the Dutch ship "Vroun Johanna", a soldier-servant to Batt van Waldeck.


The census of 1826 states the following: Willem Volkwein, wife Alida Volkwijn, daughters Carolina & Elisabeth, son Daniel (1.4, 1.8, 1.9) had a house and premises situated in Table Valley. Deed of Transfer 10th June 1819 indel. 1st February 1826 final 28th December 1827, the address 6 Boom Street. His Death Notice states his names as being "Daniel Wilhelm Volkwein commonly known as Wilhelm Volkwein", his age at 70 years 2 months and 11 days and puts his origin as "Ehlen Wilhelmshöke Keser Hessen neare/2 mulen van Cassel". When he died, he was living at 21 Waterkant Street, Cape Town. The children marked thus (\*) were alive at the time of his death.

He signed his name on his wife's death notice: W Volkwein

The DRC Marriage Register 1804-1872 pg.23 reports a LODEWŸK VOLKWŸN of Hessen being married on 20 May 1807 to Alida VAN BRUYNSWAARD van Cabo (of the Cape). Further, L Volkwyn arrived here on 7th March 1806. Sponsors: C F Wilhelm and T G Lankhoff. Presumably, she took the surname of the spouse of her brother-in-law to be as was frequently the custom in freed slaves and in the absence of any other family name.

The British were consummate administrators. Records of the High Court of the Cape Colony.

The indictment [CSC 1/1/1/4/ case 8] reads as follows:



Signed: A Oliphant Attorney General

The jurors were empanelled and charged with the Trial of Lodewyk and Willem Volkwyn. The jury foreman, a professional position, was A Chiappini.

The findings: Lodewyk guilty Willem Volkwyn not guilty

The sentice from an unnamed judge:

To be imprisoned and kept in solitary confinement on spare diet until Tuesday morning next the 23rd inst. Then to receive Twenty-five (25) lashes on the back from a cat without knots as soon after day light as may be, in the New Market, Cape Town

Afterwards to be kept at hard labour within or without gaol as H.E. the Gov. may direct for the term of Three (3) years

Dorothea Selli Wiid was a minor when she married D W Volkwyn. He was a widower. Their bands were read in church and she was given away by her mother. She is called Selli Dorothia Wiid in the DRC Marriage Register and on her Death Notice; and lived at 128 Long Street and died in the home of her son-in-law HJW Ross (written "Rofs", a butcher by trade) 74 Buitengracht St., Cape Town. She was totally illiterate.

"Daniel Wilhelm Volkwyn Jnr. a carpenter by trade commenced as a Retail Dealer near the Castle Bridge and might have done well had he attended to his own trade and left the shop in charge of his family but like too many others finding the facilities for getting credit easy, he gradually became careless and not being economical, he soon got into difficulties etc. Advert filed: 29th May 1874 & 1st June 1874. Expires 14th June 1874" Brittain.

Sophia Elizabeth Volkwyn née JANTZEN left an estate of £697/6/0 to her family. Those alive at the time are denoted thus (\*). With the death of HJWV, and with the permission of 1.8.13 Benjamin Alan (Johann) Frederick Volkwyn, the property was minimally restored and sold on 28 May 1935 for £625. MOOC 13/1/2843 No.218

Maria Agnes Pelteret originally of Palmboom Road, Newlands, died in 3 Princess St, Mowbray, leaving her son "as he sole and universal heir.....", in a will dated 2 June 1897.  $\boxed{\text{MOOC } 6/9/879 \text{ No.1106}}$ . The estate was worth £75/0/0. There was considerable debate in the settling of this estate. It apparently involved "excessive fees" and GWNV being "out of pocket" after searching for and finding beneficiaries of which there were several (presumably through a later codicil) and the estate of the late D W de Cerff in some manner.

DISCLAIMER: This is a working paper published in the hope that it will assist others in finalising a document.

Our use of racial epithets, though unfortunate and certainly not our preference, we have considered it a necessity whilst the process of defining a hugely confusing genealogy continues. Hopefully, these will fall away with time.

### The VOLKWYN of KNYSNA / GEORGE / MOSSEL BAY FAMILY LINE

Much of the early documentation from the Eastern Cape was completed with little attention to detail. Often the names are spelled phonetically and are nicknames rather than those given at birth or baptism. Frequently, the family historian appears to have been illiterate.

One is tempted to generalise by saying that the information on documents dating from the  $mid-20^{th}$  century often is frugal to the point of being disdainful and dismissive.

Much of that which follows, thus, is developed around less than ideal information and conceivably is wrong in part.

To contextualise the district of George, and thus the likely sources of records, herewith a few historical details.

Georgetown was founded in 1811 and created a municipality in 1837.

Dutch Reformed Church was built in 1842

St. Peter and St. Paul Roman Catholic Church was founded in 1843

St. Mark's Cathedral was founded in 1850

Reputedly, papers relating to the Volkwyn family, Pacaltsdorp mission churces, George are lodged in archives at the University of the Western Cape.

The Volkwyn Chair is a late regency chair originally created by the coloured furniture makers of that name who lived in the Mossel Bay - George - Knysna areas. Examples of their art in the form of "spin span" chairs exist dating from the early 19<sup>th</sup> century. The Volkwyn Chair design is thought to date from the early 20<sup>th</sup> century, possibly originating with one, **Isaac Theodore Volkwyn** or "Tak".

This was good humouredly questioned by a descendent, Volkwyn Isaac Theodore, 1908 - 2002.

The features of the chair are turned front legs with rounded side stretchers; a wide seat that overhangs the seat rails; a transverse spindle between the uprights below which lies a wide rail with a thinner rail below; between these rails are inserted two to three spindles; often followed by another thin rail with four bobbins in between.

The design is thought to have travelled to the hinterland of Eastern Cape, manifesting there as the  $Grahamstown\ Chair$ .

Based on the Death Notices of Pieter Volkwyn and Magdalena Duison née Isaac, I believe that that which follows represents the "best guess" situation as regards the Georgetown Volkwyn Family Tree in the first and second generations.

He married my mother on 4 January 1941. He worked as a shoemaker's assistant and then branched off into the Hotel trade. He worked as a waiter at the Drostdy Hotel in Graaff- Reinet and then went to the St. George's Club in Port Elizabeth. He trained and assisted quite a few managers at the St. George's Club, but because of Apartheid could never become one. My mother was a dressmaker."

C M Lind, Attorney, Notary and Auctioneer of Oudtshoorn complaining about the lack of co-operation on the part of Maria wrote ~ "could we not include in notice of motion (to the Supreme Court) a prayer for her removal on the grounds of her wilfully flittering away the substance of the estate on her factious opposition?". In another letter, after Maria L. had laid a complaint against Lind to the Supreme Court, he describes her as "an impudent and half idiotic person and certainly not fit to occupy a position of trust".

The estate was finalised on "a *rule nisi* being made absolute for the removal of the said Respondent, M Lowies helped by Japhta Lowies, from her said office with costs" dated 12 Dec 1899.

Volkwyn Isaac Theodore was first a schoolteacher, later becoming head of a teachers' training college and later practised as an influential attorney, notary and conveyancer.

#### Isaac Theodore Volkwyn

was born in George on the 28th June 1908. He later came to Cape Town to further his education and became a teacher, at Battswood. He taught at Wesley Training College, in De Aar, Touwsriver and many other schools. During his teaching career he furthered his studies through UNISA and became the first coloured lawyer and notary public in 1950. He studied law so that he could help the underprivileged.

He married Doris Essex in 1950 and had 4 children, Diana, Michael, Roy and Barbara and later 6 grandchildren and thereafter 2 great grandchildren.

He was a man of integrity and never forgot his origins-a man's humanity is first. His basic approach to racial barries was not so much to complain about them as to ignore them by concentrating on the sheer quality of his work. Isaac Volkwyn was a powerful individualist, given to sudden passions which have, in some respects, been tempered with time and in others not. He could sometimes be single-minded and even obstinate in his cause and never feared to take up a crusade single-handedly. He was a humble and caring man, a man of few words and rather reserved.

He was a keen golf player and gardener and played golf up until the time of his death. For many years up until the time of his death he grew the most beautiful orchids, tending to them on a daily basis. He was extremely health conscious and believed in homeopathic remedies and the medicinal properties of herbs. He used to exercise regularly on his exercise bicycle and later his treadmill.

Inscribed thereon is H J Volkwyn (born 11.11.1853 in Georgetown, Cape Province died 12.12.1918). The grave-site is a couple of hundred metres back from the Metsemotlabe River <sup>1</sup>. The railway is about a km away. The current main tar road, about 20 years old, is closer than the original road which was about half a km away towards the railway line.
