MAJOR J G MAYNARD

Major J G Maynard was of the Bethune's Mounted Infantry. He was awarded the Queen's South Africa Medal 1899-1902 with battle clasps Tugela Heights, Relief Ladysmith (28 February 1900), and Laing's Nek (May 1900), and state clasps Cape Colony, Orange Free State and Transvaal; and the King's South Africa Medal with date clasps South Africa 1901 and South Africa 1902. Verified

Bethune's Mounted Infantry was raised in Durban on $16^{\rm th}$ October 1899 with an establishment of 500 men. The Commanding Officer was Maj. E.C. Bethune of the $16^{\rm th}$ Lancers. Famous for its involvement in Buller's Tugela Heights, it served throughout the South African War 1899-1902 in all areas.
