

MAJOR J G MAYNARD

Major J G Maynard was of the Bethune's Mounted Infantry. He was awarded the Queen's South Africa Medal 1899-1902 with battle clasps Tugela Heights, Relief Ladysmith (28 February 1900), and Laing's Nek (May 1900), and state clasps Cape Colony, Orange Free State and Transvaal; and the King's South Africa Medal with date clasps South Africa 1901 and South Africa 1902. Verified

Bethune's Mounted Infantry was raised in Durban on 16th October 1899 with an establishment of 500 men. The Commanding Officer was Maj. E.C. Bethune of the 16th Lancers. Famous for its involvement in Buller's Tugela Heights, it served throughout the South African War 1899-1902 in all areas.
