CONYERS HARRY BURTON

Conyers Harry Burton was born in London July 1865, the son of Conyers, a Lithographic Printer, and Harriet Burton. He was one of 7 children. He married Ada Rosina GREENWAYS in Croydon in April 1901. Together, they had two children, Gladys Evelyn Burton and Phyllis Ada ANDERSEN. He was a Commercial Artist by trade, and when retired lived at "Ottawa" 2 Avenue, Fish Hoek where he died. His estate was valued at £. 401/8/0. His daughters, friends of my mother, returned to England following their retirement.
