JOHN FLOYDE LEWIS ESQ and WALTER ALLAN BOIS

The CORRESPONDENCE SERIES is an investigation into the background of recipients of British prestamped postal stationery. The "collection" was purchased in South Africa in 1999 as a job lot, the which took me six months to sort and mount, creating a collection spanning 140 years. I have no idea of the provenance.

The Reference work is British Postal Stationery, A K Huggins.1970. The first date with catalogue number refers to the year when the pre-stamped envelope was first issued; the second, the year when the envelope was actually used.

Brief Comment:

John Floyd(e) Lewis (1853 Newport - 1934 Newport) lived in Newport, Monmouthshire; was married in 1878 to Fanny Louisa (Rosina - sic) NN (1856 New Romney, Kent - 1930 Newport) and had at least 3 daughters and a son, Florence Odelia Lewis (1884-), Winifred Mary (May) Lewis (1885-) and Lilian Lewis (1888-) and Trevor Floyde Lewis (1893 Newport - 1951 Southampton). J F Lewis was a vaccination officer for Newport, Monmouthshire ¹.

Walter Allen Bois (1854-1924) lived in Camberwell. In 1885, he married Ellen Phillippa (Pippa) WITTS (1861-1923). There appear to have been no offspring. W A Bois was a wine merchant.
